f) What should our attitude be towards other people?

g) Are all people created equal?

5.a) What is the relationship of man with the rest of creation (1:26 & 28)?

b) How do people today abuse their rule over creation?

6.a) What did God do on the seventh day (2:2-3)?

b) What does this tell us about work and rest?

7. How should we respond to God when we think about His creation? (See Ps. 148:1-6)
