# **TRUST IN THE LORD WITH ALL YOUR HEART**

## **Genesis 16**

### **Introduction**

Abram and Sarai had been living in Canaan now for ten years. God had promised Abram a son. But he and Sarai were well aware that she was no longer able to bear children. In the New Testament Abram is described as the man of faith (Gal. 3:9). Yet in this story Abram does not act in faith. Here we will see what happens when we act not in faith but only according to our own feelings.

5. What was the ultimate result of their impatience (v.12)? (Note: the Arabs are descendants of Ishmael and have long been in conflict with the Jews.)

6. How can we help our brothers or sisters who have fallen into sin? (See Gal. 6:1-2)

7.a) How did God deal with Hagar (vv.7-12)?

b) What does that tell us about Him?

c) What can we learn from the name that Hagar gives God (v.13)?

d) What are some of the other names of God in the Bible?
