Genesis 27:41—28:22

Introduction

Esau held a grudge against Jacob for cheating him of his father's blessing. He had only to wait until his father's death and then he would repay his brother. But God had other plans. As Jacob flees from his brother the Lord meets him in dream and reveals himself to him for the first time.
