Genesis 38

Introduction

To understand the story of Judah and Tamar we need to understand the ancient West Asian custom of 'brother-in-law marriage'. According to this custom if a married man should die without a male heir it was the duty of the man's younger brother to marry the widow. This was in order to produce offspring that would be counted as belonging to the man who had died. Later God made the custom of brother-in-law marriage into a law for Israel to make sure that the family name would continue (Dt. 25:5-6). The story we read in this chapter is one of the most sordid stories in the Bible. Not all the stories in the Bible are beautiful and encouraging. But they are all included for a purpose (2Tim. 3:16-17).

5. Why is it wrong to have sexual relations outside of marriage? (See 1Cor. 6:18-20)

6.a) When it was discovered that Tamar was pregnant what did Judah order to be done to her (v.24)?

b) Do you think Judah would have been so angry if he had discovered a man rather than a woman guilty of a similar sin?

c) What does God think about a society that blames women more than men? (See Hos. 4:14 & Jn. 8:1-11)

7. Was Tamar more righteous than Judah (v.26)?

8. What are some of the possible reasons why God chose to include such a sordid story in the Bible? (See Dt. 9:4-6 & Mt. 1:1-3)

9. What hope is there for people who have lived sinful lives? (See Eph. 2:1-10)
