5. Read Matthew 5:45 & Romans 2:4.

a) In what ways does God show kindness to all people?

b) Why does he show that kindness?

c) How do most people respond to God's kindness?

d) How did Joseph's brothers respond to his kindness (Gen. 43:34)?

e) Joseph's brothers still did not know his identity. In what way is that similar to most people today in their relationship to God?

f) How can we help people to see the kindness of God towards them?
